GOLFING GUEST GUIDELINES

Guest Classifications

- Accompanied Guest(s): Guest who is accompanied by an SHCC member.
- Unaccompanied Guest(s): Guest who plays at SHCC without being accompanied by a SHCC member. Prior approval required.
- Family Guest(s): Guest who is a member's spouse, son, daughter, mother, father, grandchildren, brother, or sister that are over the age of 25 and do not have any other golf privileges through the Club.

Guidelines

- All guests are required to check in with the caddie master upon arrival.
- · Pace of play is 4 hours or less.
- Guest play is restricted on Tuesdays, Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays until after 10:00am.
- Unaccompanied guests may visit the Club for Golf on a limited basis through prior arrangement with the Director of Golf or General Manager.
- Unaccompanied guests are required to use a caddie or forecaddie, if available.

Cell Phones

- Cell phones must be kept on silent or vibrate in all locations.
- They are permitted for use beyond the first tee with the agreement of the members of the foursome playing.
- Such use must not slow the pace of play or disturb other golfers who are in the area.
- Visual use only while in the Main Clubhouse, Dining Room, and Locker Rooms.

Smoking

- Defined by Ohio Law, smoking is permitted on:
 - Pub Patio between the fire pit and 9th fairway
 - Golf Course, Driving Range, & Putting/Chipping Greens
- It is prohibited in all other areas of Clubhouse and Club Property.
- Where smoking is permitted, smokers are asked to be courteous toward others in the area
